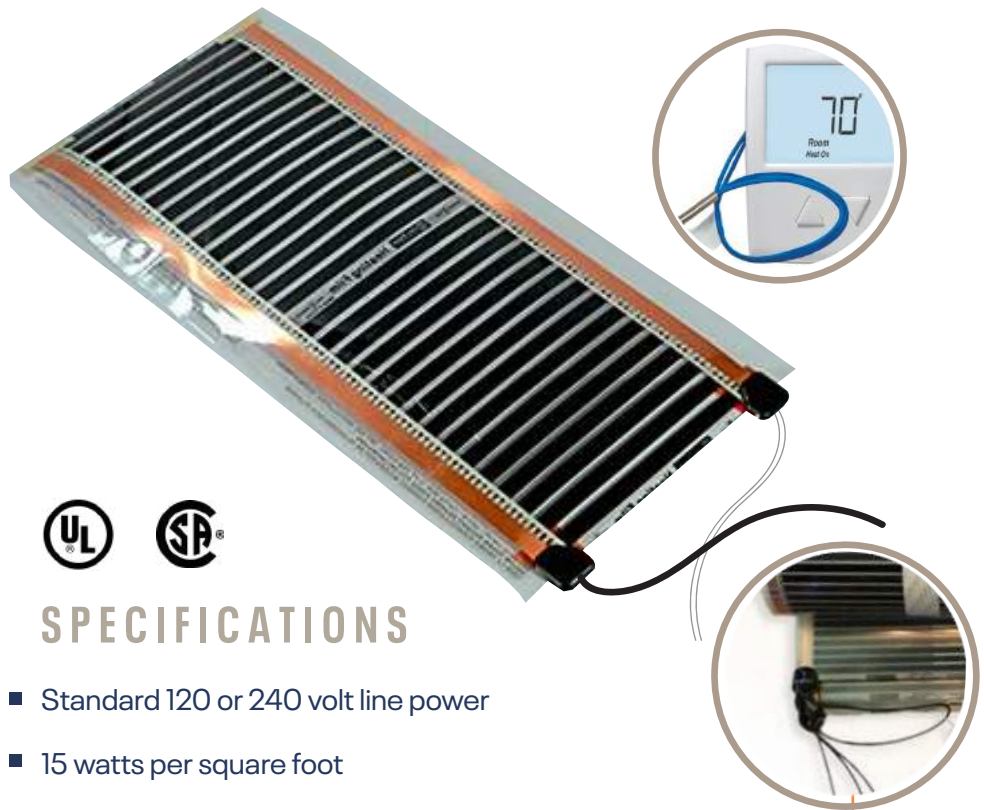

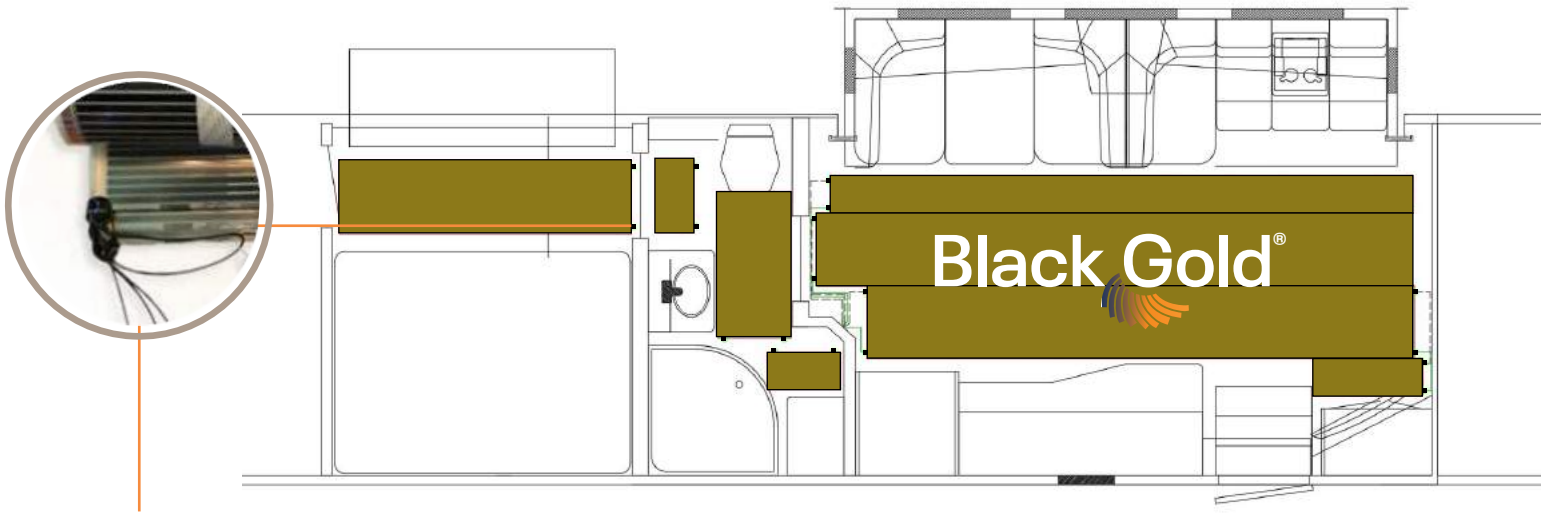

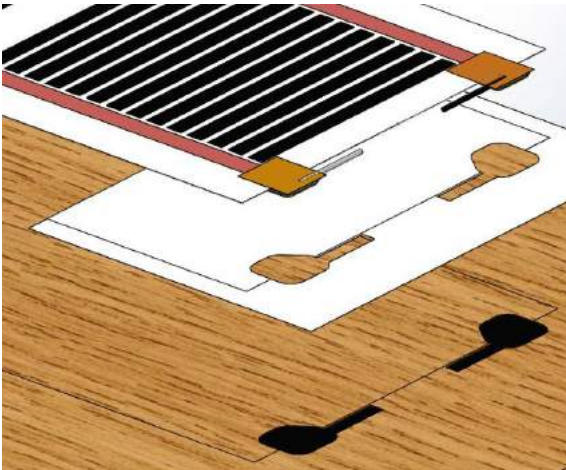
## LUXURY MOTOR COACH FLOOR PLAN



Black Gold's proprietary-design terminations are sealed in rigid thermoplastic. No special connector needed!

Black Gold™ is a thin, pre-terminated and pre-cut radiant floor heat film that lays on top of the subfloor, under the flooring material adding just 1/16" to the total floor stack-up\*.

\* Total stack-up varies with flooring material



During a typical installation, pockets and grooves are routed into the subfloor to accept the cold lead wires.

The Black Gold film is adhered to the subfloor and the flooring material is installed on top.
